To promote excellence in book arts, the CCA Libraries is sponsoring its annual CCA Student Book Art Competition. Each year one book by a CCA student will be selected for inclusion in the library's artist book collection. The book as an expressive art form can be made from many types of materials and created in many media. Some have words; some are purely visual.

If you are a current CCA student and have created a book as part of a class, you are eligible to submit up to three books.

Exhibition - one or more entries per student
will be exhibited in **Meyer Library, April 9-May 11**, as space permits

Entry rules

1. You must be a current CCA student.
2. Work on the book submitted must be in conjunction with a CCA course.
3. Books will be evaluated on originality, depth of concept, craft, sensitivity to materials, relationship of materials and form to content, and use of the book form as important to the work.
4. Books should not exceed twelve inches in any direction.
5. The winning entries become the property of the CCA Libraries.
6. CCA and the library assume no responsibility for damage or loss of work during the competition. Books not chosen for an award must be picked up by May 25th. CCA ID is required for pickup. CCA and the library are not responsible for books that are not picked up.
