Donald Lipski, who has lived in New York City since the mid-1970's, is spending the year in San Francisco. Coming to town without materials or pre-conceptions, he will be creating a work for Capp Street Project from materials he finds in the Bay Area.

Lipski's works range in scale from grams to tons, and while materially rich are deeply layered with meaning. His works have been shown internationally and are in numerous major museum collections. He has been awarded a Guggenheim Fellowship, several National Endowment for the Arts Fellowships, and is a 1993 recipient of an Academy Award from the American Academy of Arts and Letters.
