

What is Art & Architecture Source?

Art & Architecture Source is an online database subscribed to by the **CCA Libraries** (libraries.cca.edu). It contains full-text articles from over 700 journals and magazines in fine arts, crafts, design and architecture, as well as citations and abstracts from hundreds more print magazines and journals.

Fifteen of the 20 most-widely cited journals in the visual studies are included in our subscription.

2002 to present

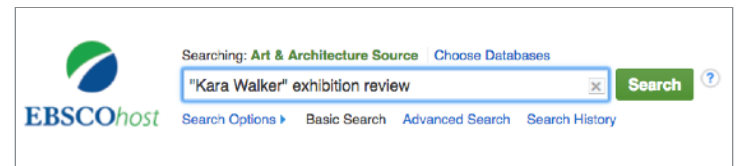


Index of print issues

SEARCH STRATEGIES

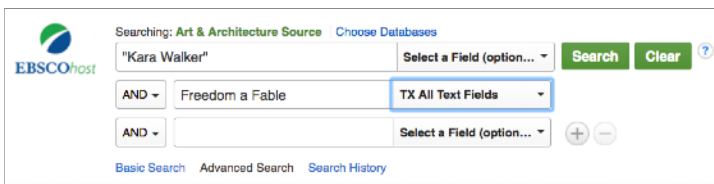
Good keyword strategies include:

- Names of artists.
- Specific styles, genres, or art movements.
- Types of articles, such as exhibition reviews, artist interviews, etc.
- Use quotation marks around exact names & phrases.



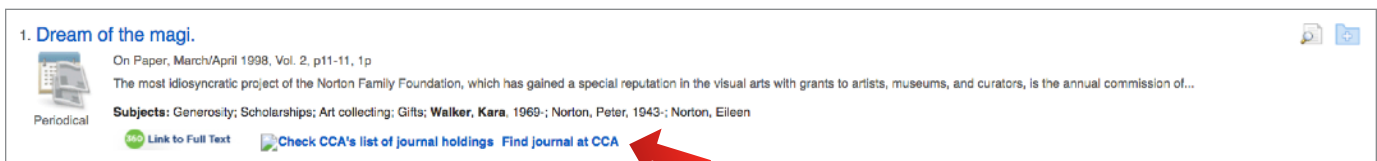
Try **Advanced Search**:

- Find specific artists, concepts, or artworks by searching the *complete text* of articles by setting a search field to **TX All Text**.
- Limit results to specific published dates (e.g., 2006-present, or 1900-1950).



After you search, you can refine your results using checkboxes and sliders to the left of the screen. Results can be filtered by **full-text content**, **year published**, **source types**, **subjects**, and more.

If the database does not contain the full-text of an article, click **Find Journal at CCA** to discover if CCA Libraries have it in print. Current print issues are on display in Simpson and Meyer Libraries. Back issues (two years old and older) are bound in annual volumes and displayed in alpha/chronological order. Print issues in Meyer Library can be delivered to Simpson Library and vice versa.



You can track sources in **Art & Architecture Source** by using the folder icon, email articles to yourself, and automatically format MLA citations.
